Welcome Back

Primary 1 Parents – Phonics Meeting

We will be holding our Phonics meeting for Primary 1 parents on Wednesday 17th January at 9.15am. During the meeting teachers will explain the programme and parents will be equipped to support their children's learning at home with particular reference to reading and language development. Translation will be provided for Polish parents in one of the sessions. We would encourage parents to attend what is always a very valued opportunity to learn about their children's experiences in school.

Incredible Years (Primary 1-3 Parents)

The Incredible Years programme is an excellent programme that we organise each year in partnership with Ballykeel PS. It is designed to support parents with their children's development at home and covers areas such as setting boundaries on behaviour, supporting children's learning, strengthening children's emotional health and social skills and setting rules, routines and limits at home etc. The feedback from participants in recent years has been excellent and we would encourage parents to take up the places that are available as they are limited. The programme lasts for 6 sessions and all are delivered in Ballykeel PS by trained staff. Exact dates and times are not available just yet but sessions take place in the morning (usually 9.15am-11.15am) during February- March and crèche facilities are provided for parents attending. Transport can also be provided for parents attending and everything is funded so there is no cost to attend. If you are interested please contact Mrs. Brady as soon as possible. Parents who have previously completed the programme are welcome to attend again.

Primary 2 Ready to Learn (RTL)
